TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. Any member with subscriptions in arrears will not receive preference in the draw.
2. Any entrant unable to accept a place after the draw will not forfeit any entry fee.
3. Withdrawals within 7 days of the stake will forfeit **full** entry fee, for whatever reason, except for accidental physical injury to the dog entered, at the discretion of the committee and supported by a veterinary certificate or having gained a qualification excluding it from the stake.
4. Separate cheques must be sent for each entry.
5. Only one entry will be accepted from each member for preference in the draw for each stake. (In case of multiple entries please state preference).
6. Entrants who get a run in the first Novice Stake will not receive preference in the draw for any other Novice Stake that season.
7. **Qualifying Stake.** Highest award(s) must be entered clearly and specifically.
8. No Cheques will be returned unless requested and accompanied by S.A.E.
9. Should any Stake have to be abandoned due to weather conditions and no alternative date in the current season be offered entry fees for those on the card will only be returned if requested within 28 days of the original date.
10. No Substitutions whilst Reserves Stand.
11. Rule J8.B. (11) (12) will apply to all trials.
12. Unless there are special circumstances, all competitors will be expected to stay until the end of the Stake.
13. Only the handler whose name appears on the official entry form may handle the dog on the day.

Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity. No modification will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
