- 12:30pm**      **Dog training & agility demonstration**  
Charlie Clarricoates, behaviourist, trainer and renowned author will be here with his team to provide an entertaining and informative demonstration of Dog Training & Agility skills.
- 1:00pm**      **Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers**  
More commonly known as 'Toller's', this is one of the most unusual breeds of gundog. When working, it is sent into the water to lure waterfowl and Jenny Parker will be showing the skill of this breed.
- 1:30pm**      **Working gundog display**

This handsome breed of gundog is often used for hunting, pointing and retrieving but it is a highly intelligent dog and can be used for practically anything from companions to assistance dogs. Linda Mayne from the Italian Spinone club will describe the extraordinary qualities of the breed.

Charlie Clarricoates will be back with us to demonstrate a gun dog scurry - a timed competition which aims to find the dog that retrieves a dummy in the fastest time. Following the demonstration, you will have a chance to put your own dog through its paces.

These gentle giants are well known for their natural life-saving skills and the members of this club meet regularly to train in water rescue techniques. They are well suited to this because of their webbed feet and dense, oily coat. They have superb temperaments and are ideal dogs around children.
